TINLEY CREEK STREAM BANK STABILIZATION

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

The Village of Orland Park, and its contractor, Copenhaver Construction Inc., are scheduled to begin the Tinley Creek Streambank Stabilization Project in your area during the week of March 1, 2026. Work will occur within easement areas granted along Tinley Creek between W. 151st Street and approximately 800 lineal feet south of Crystal Creek Drive. Construction will begin near Crystal Creek Drive and progress north toward W. 151st Street.

The purpose of the project is to stabilize the creek banks, maintain/improve water flow in the creek, and prevent further erosion using proven armoring techniques such as gabion basket walls, sheet pile walls, soldier pile walls, and rock protection. Work will also include selective tree removal, regrading of the banks, and landscape restoration with new trees and shrubs. Construction is expected to be substantially complete by December 2026, with some landscape restoration activities possibly continuing into Spring 2027.

During construction, access to your property is expected to be maintained at all times. However, some temporary disruption and construction related noise are unavoidable. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this project might cause and appreciate your patience and cooperation.
